


6. INSTALLATION PRECAUTIONS / NOTES:


A WARNING

- DO-NOT transport kayaks without securing bow and stern to front and rear of vehicle.
- DO NOT transport kayaks without securing TO THE CARRIER.
- DO NOT USE rope with less than 1/4" (6 mm) diameter for bow and stern line.
- SECURE kayak straps INBOARD to vehicle rack towers (see step 9b).
- DO NOT exceed kayak carrier content weight limit of 157 lbs. (71 kg.)
- DO NOT exceed your rack's weight limit:



• ALWAYS fold rear hoop before folding front hoop (fold when not in use).






NOTE: If using horizontal Mighty Mounts with bar caps, attach METAL caps to front bar, PLASTIC caps to rear bar.

2) Attach bar caps (if included with Mighty Mounts), opening caps toward FRONT of car.


- 3) Install FRONT hoop folding toward REAR of car.
 - a) Insert button head screws through base plate and into Mighty Mounts.
 - b) TIGHTEN button-head screws with wrench (from Mighty Mount kit).
- 4) Install REAR hoop folding toward FRONT of car.
 - a) Insert button head screws through base plate and into Mighty Mounts.
 - b) TIGHTEN button-head screws with wrench (from Mighty Mount kit).

NOTE: When not in use, ALWAYS fold rear hoop before folding the front hoop.




5) Raise kayak carrier hoop into vertical position. Check button head screws once more for security.


6) Load boat and attach straps through kayak carrier hoops, inboard to vehicle rack towers.



7) Slide rubber buckle protector off the buckle.




8) Depress tab in buckle, and insert end of plain strap into buckle as shown.



- 9) Tighten straps completely.
 - a) PULL strap end to tighten.
 - b) Run kayak straps INBOARD to vehicle rack towers.

10) Replace buckle protector by sliding over buckle.



- 11) Tie down kayak to vehicle for safe transport.
 - a) Use at least 1/4" line to attach the kayak's bow and stern to the front and rear of the vehicle.

NOTE: Apply a cushion/pad to hood or bumper fascia to protect paint from scratches or scuffs from the bow line.
