


## **Clutch Master Cylinder**

## **REMOVAL & INSTALLATION**

NOTE: Replace the clutch master cylinder and slave cylinder as a set for added reliability.

1. Disconnect the master cylinder pushrod from the clutch pedal.



- 2. Remove the hydraulic line from the master cylinder being careful not to damage the compression fitting.
- 3. Remove the two bolts holding the clutch master cylinder to the engine compartment.

## **WARNING**

Brake fluid dissolves paint. Do not allow it to drip onto the body when removing the master cylinder. If any does get on the paint, wipe it off immediately.

## To install:

- 4. Install the master cylinder and tighten the mounting bolts to 6–8 ft. lbs. (8–11 Nm). Partially tighten the hydraulic line and then tighten the cylinder mounting bolts.
- 5. Connect the pushrod to the clutch pedal.
- 6. Bleed the system and adjust the clutch pedal.



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
